

Teller Lecture & Banquet

The 30th Annual Edward Teller Lecture & Banquet will be held October 28, 2021. This annual event allows the nuclear community to come together to recognize our Fred C. Davidson Distinguished Scientist Award winner, our Nuclear Service Award winner, our many educator and student award winners, and hear from a leading expert in the nuclear community.

Our distinguished guest speaker is Brent Park. Dr. Park is a physicist, a retired national laboratory executive and a former Deputy Administrator for Defense Nuclear Nonproliferation at the National Nuclear Security Administration (DOE/NNSA). Prior to joining DOE/NNSA, Brent retired from Oak Ridge National Laboratory (ORNL) where he led and managed the science-to-application efforts for national security programs. Before ORNL, Brent was the director of NNSA's Remote Sensing Laboratory, where he led efforts to advance and field cutting-edge diagnostics and communications instruments in support of counterterrorism and radiological incident response for the nation.
