21st Annual CNTA Charity Golf Tournament will be Held on May 12

Jim Marra, the Executive Director of Citizens for Nuclear Technology Awareness (CNTA), today released details of the 21st Annual CNTA Charity Golf Tournament to be held on Friday, May 12, at Houndslake Country Club in Aiken, SC.

“Registration will begin at 7:30 a.m. and the Captain’s Choice tournament with a shotgun start will commence at 8:30 a.m. The lunch ceremony will follow play,” said Marra. “It will be a spectacular golf outing with 120 players expected to participate in the one-day tournament.”

“Besides being a fun event and a great networking opportunity for participants, this tournament is one of CNTA’s most important annual fundraisers,” he continued. “With so many nuclear related activities in our community, this event will help CNTA promote and educate the public on nuclear technologies.”

The CNTA golf tournament in 2022 included 26 teams and raised \$21,000 for CNTA’s educational programs.

Opportunities for additional sponsorships, teams, and single players include:

- Raffle Sponsor - \$1,800 and includes two foursomes, and banner display. The player’s packs for the foursome include range balls, green fees, carts, and lunch.
