Financials

- 2022 Year End Financials
 - o Ended the year with a net of about \$5,000.
 - o Were on target with budget, but expenses have gone up.
 - o The endowment held with the Community Foundation took a loss on the year.
 - o Budget increases for 2023 are in line with how 2022 ended.
 - Are considering where to increase expenses as we want to have a cushion but want to utilize the money given to CNTA for education and advocacy.

 - The winning team was Kennedy Middle School. Their design included a molten salt reactor.
