Call to Order

- Steve Sheetz called the meeting to order at 7:31 a.m.
- A quorum was present.

Minutes

- Motion to Approve the Minutes from the Board of Directors meeting held June 22, 2023 as presented.
 - o Moved- Mancilla, Second- Bartelmo
 - o Motion to approve the minutes as presented passed unanimously.

Financials

- Profit & Loss Statement through August 22, 2023
 - o Two fall events both already above anticipated income. Expect their expenses to be higher than budgeted as well.
 - The event/program income already at 100% of budgeted for the year, so will have higher income than anticipated in this category.
 - o Membership is lagging but will catch up with renewals due in September & October.
 - Membership has 3 peak times for renewals- December/January, June, and October.
 - o Anticipate roughly \$55,000-\$60,000 in expenses still for the year.

Board Chair

- Nominating committee for 2024 board members will be chaired by Forest Mahan.
 - o Will have names for who is on the nominating committee to the board in September.
 - o Mancilla, Ferarra, and Kirk volunteered to sit on the committee.
 - o Currently have at least one seat open to fill for next year.

- o Mahan has reached out to board members at the end of their three-year term to see who will renew for another three years and who will roll off to open seats.
- Will also need to vote on officers.
 - Vice Chair will become chair, need a new vice chair, and treasurer can renew or ask to be replaced.
- o Will present the final slate of candidates for consideration at the October board meeting.

Communications Committee

- Nuclear Science Week Insert
 - O Stories are in to the Aiken Standard.
 - o Waiting on draft of the final layout.
- Press Releases
 - o Recently sent out two- new executive director, and July Up & Atom
 - Have many in the processes for this fall
 - Essay contest and educator grant program will be released during Nuclear Science Week

 - o Both are in the works for 2024. Will launch in October.
 - o Press releases, application materials etc. all ready to go.
- Fall Fission Festival from the SRS Museum
 - October 21st from 1-4pm.
 - o Education committee wants to sponsor this at the \$500 level.
 - o Paul Ebel will spearhead the table/candy giveaway.
 - o Board of directors in unanimous agreement CNTA should support this program.
- STEM Outreach
 - o Working on redoing the entire CNTA poster board we use for education outreach.
 - Focus on more photos, more material approachable to children.
 - SEED on September 23rd.
 - First call for volunteers went well but have holes from 11-3 that we need filled.
 - Volunteers will be at Ridge-Spring Monetta middle and high schools on October 24th.
 - Teaching middle school science and high school chemistry classes.
 - o Marra will be speaking to the Kiwanis Club of Aiken today.
- Center for Lifelong Learning
 - o Meeting with Jim Tisaranni today to discuss CNTA's participation next year.
 - o Discussion- center has a need for more classes and variety of topics.
 - Committee wants to teach a three-part course on "What we've learned from nuclear incidents."
 - Have a list of classes we've taught previously.
