Call to Order

- Steve Sheetz called the meeting to order at 7:31 a.m.
- A quorum was present.

Minutes

- Motion to Approve the Minutes from the Board of Directors meeting held August 24, 2023 as presented.
 - o Moved- Mahan, Second- Mancilla
 - o Motion to approve the minutes as presented passed unanimously.

Financials

- Profit & Loss Statement through September 26, 2023
 - Over 100% anticipated income on events line item already.
 - o Membership income should reach 100% by the end of the year.
 - o Utilities & salaries line items will probably be overbudget in expenses due to increased costs.
- 2024 Operating Budget
 - Will be presented to the board next month.
 - o Will be voted upon at the November meeting.
- Financial Control Policy
 - o CNTA has had no official policy on financial expenditures.
 - o Policy is straightforward & addresses the need for differentiated accountability in our finances.
 - o Motion to approve the financial control policy as presented.
 - Moved- Freeman-Pollard, Second- Allender
 - Motion to approve the financial control policy passed unanimously.

Board Chair

- Nominating committee for 2024 board members is set.
 - o Committee is: Mahan, Sheetz, Ferrara & Kirk.
 - o Have two vacancies to fill for 2024 board.
 - o Have seven board members renewing for another three years. Have one board member choosing to roll off the board.
 - Looking for nominations for the open seats.
 - o Will present the final slate of candidates for consideration at the October board meeting.
- 2024-2025 Officers
 - o Mahan will become chair of the board, Sheetz will move to immediate past chair.
 - o Charles Hansen will remain as treasurer.
 - Need a new vice-chair. Is a six-year total commitment.
 - o Two years as vice chair, two years as chair, two years as past chair.
 - o Have one nomination so far. Send nominations to Mahan.
- Bylaws Update
 - o Special committee will be formed in 2024 to review & update the CNTA Bylaws.
 - o Last updated in 2016.
 - Have a list of areas that need updated/addressed including adding virtual meetings, changing the proxy voting language etc.
 - o Committee will be chaired by Sheetz. Will call for volunteers in January to join the committee.

 - o Will have volunteers at the SC Governor's School for the Arts in Greenville on October 23rd.
