Job Posting: NuWaDi Consortium Grant Project Director

Job Description:

Citizens for Nuclear Technology Awareness (CNTA) is seeking a project director to facilitate our participation in the NuWaDi (Nuclear Waste Dialogue) consortium. This contract part-time position would facilitate CNTA's capacity building and assist us in creating an implementation grant proposal for the consortium.

The planning grant project summary is: CNTA plans to build the organization's capacity to facilitate and participate in community conversations surrounding nuclear waste and consent-based siting while investigating how terminology used impacts public opinion. The full implementation grant would build off this start an utilize our resources and network to have informed conversations on what the public would want to know, what their concerns would be, and whether certain approaches to the terminology result in more positive responses from the public.

Additional tasks could include assisting CNTA to increase staffing and technology support, interacting with community leaders, and participate in two focus groups of nuclear leaders to discuss terminology and how to make the topic of consent-based siting more approachable for the public.

Responsibilities:

- Assist the Executive Director in overseeing the planning grant. The specifics of the grant are available upon request.
- Coordinate the development of the \$100,000 implementation grant. If awarded, oversee all aspects of this project.

Qualifications & Skills:

- Experience in project management including the budget process
- Experience in grant proposal process or comparable process (bid project process)
- Knowledge of the issues surrounding storage of nuclear materials
- Experience with the Department of Energy consent-based siting process and other relevant policies
- Existing relationships with community leaders and stakeholders in the policy process

Salary & Benefits:

The planning grant funds this position from June (hire date) until August. A funded implementation grant would continue this position for approximately another year. The initial approved funds for this position are \$2,500, plus approved travel reimbursements. The continuation amount is negotiable and would be included as part of the total \$100,000 grant.

As this is a 1099 contract position, CNTA will not offer any benefits.
