Savannah River Site (SRS) summer interns will be the featured speakers at the Citizens for Nuclear Technology Awareness (CNTA) Up & Atom breakfast on July 17. The Up & Atom breakfasts are sponsored by CNTA to provide nuclear-related information to the organization's members and the community.

Hundreds of college students come from across the country to spend the summer interning in many departments and divisions at SRS. Three interns, one each from Savannah River Mission Completion, Savannah River National Laboratory, and Savannah River Nuclear Solutions, will speak. Dozens of other interns will also be in attendance.

CNTA will also be recognizing our 2024 High School Essay Contest Winners and our 2024 Educator Grant Awardees at this breakfast. The winning students wrote essays about the use of nuclear technology in medicine, energy, or space exploration. The grant awardees are all area teachers who submitted projects for STEM education supplies in their classrooms.
