## Call to Order

### **Minutes**

- Motion to Approve the Minutes from the Board of Directors meeting held January 23, 2025 as presented.
  - o Motion-Hopperton, Second-Cloessner
  - o Motion to approve the minutes as presented approved by unanimous consent.

## **Guest Presentation**

- Students from the Security Operations Center at the University of South Carolina Aiken presented their report on the status of CNTA's cybersecurity investigation.
  - Proposed CNTA Cybersecurity policy presented
    - Will review and bring recommendation to the board in June
  - o In the fall will create a checklist for a 'catastrophe plan'
  - o CNTA thanks the students and advisors of the center for their time and expertise.

#### **Financials**

- Profit & Loss Statement through March 25, 2025
  - Note the 6-mo CD has matured and the funds have been reallocated to the money market account.
    - Anticipate expending roughly \$65,000 this spring from grant funds which seeded the CD funds.
  - o Golf tournament income is about \$30,000 right now.
  - o Membership renewals are coming in as anticipated.

- o Travel line-item will be over budget.
  - Budgeted for two to attend WM symposia, but Clemson said they'd reimburse for the third to attend.
    - Will reimburse about \$3,000 of this line-item's expenses in this travel grant.
- 2024 CNTA 990 tax filings
  - o Presented to the board. Will need approval before the May 15<sup>th</sup> filing deadline.
  - o If you have questions please send to Allison before the next meeting.

  - Center for Life Enrichment- Highlands-Cashiers requested a speaker from CNTA on Nuclear fuel.
    - We sent them John Kotek
    - Admiral Munns and CNTA member Chuck Goergen are both teaching classes this year for them as well.

### **Young Professionals Committee**

- Young Professional Engagement
  - o February 22- Partnering with CleanUp Aiken and the NuWaDi grant on a trash pickup.
    - Press release out on the event.
    - Was well received by attendees
  - o June 5- CNTA's Night at the Ballpark with the Augusta Greenjackets is set.

  - Will start planning details in June.
- Need to reenergize this committee.
  - o Have almost 200 young professionals in CNTA.
  - Plan a survey for all young professionals to see what they want and what they hoped to get when joining CNTA.

# **Executive Director**

- Up & Atoms
  - o March 20- CNTA Annual Meeting
    - Discussion- thoughts on this format versus previous format of Annual Meeting
      - Attendance was comparable to last year's evening event.
      - *Cost was \$1,300 less*
    - Seemed well received. Given cost and attendance keep it this format next year.
      - Consider doing it in January as a "kickoff for the year"
  - o April, May, June & July are set. See the calendar provided for specifics.
  - o Have SRNS & Southern Nuclear sponsoring Up & Atoms later this year we need to schedule.
  - o If you have ideas or your company wants to sponsor one let Allison know.
- NuWaDi Consortium Consent Based Siting Grants
  - o Are working to expend the funds in accordance with our grant proposal.
  - o The name of this program is changing from Consent to Collaborative based siting.
  - o Collected about 200 survey responses at Waste Management for our beta test and to compare experts to the public in South Carolina.
    - Southern Nuclear did a survey across their 33 sites.

- Especially interesting timing given the current Supreme Court caseload.
- o Planning 3 \$500 awards with the essay contest.
- Grant is technically on hold as it is from DOE, but we have clearance to keep doing what our grant proposal outlined.
- o Monthly grant reports are being sent to the full board to keep everyone informed of the details of the projects.
- Membership Updates
  - o Have about 450 individual members.
  - o Have 33 businesses, but 5 are expired and need contacted.
  - o Renewal notices will go out today.
- Golf Tournament
  - o Teams are full. Planning for 28 teams.
  - o Goal is to raise \$34,000. Have about \$30,000 right now.
  - o Real need with the tournament is raffle prizes and swag for golfers.
- Teller Lecture
  - Want to tie to 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of SRS.
  - o Looking for a speaker who can talk on "SRS's role in nuclear innovation" or something to that effect.
  - Are hoping to host the event in late October/early November.
  - o Planning committee for the 75<sup>th</sup> is aware of and supports these plans.
- Cybersecurity
  - o If board members want involved in the review of the USCA proposal presented today contact Allison.
    - Comment- Pare down proposed policy to what is reasonable and not time restrictive for our staff to do as part of their job, not become their job.
